THREE CATEGORIES OF MEMBERS AT CALACS

Activist (voting) members are adult women who act on their own behalf and who participate and/or help to facilitate activities. They must have completed training deemed appropriate by the organization in order to become involved in the activities.

Solidarity members (non-voting) are women and teenage girls (14 years and over) who act on their own behalf and who are interested in supporting and/or collaborating in the advancement of the sexual violence problematic without becoming militant members of the organization. CALACS Châteauguay calls on its solidarity members to participate in action activities (Examples: petitions, marches, etc.).

Supporting members (non-voting) are men or teenagers boys (14 years and over) who act on their own behalf, or groups wishing to support the cause.

**All membership requests, regardless of category, must be accepted by the collective.
(Board)**

These different categories allow a larger number of people to join as a member, thus promoting gathering and solidarity in the fight against sexual violence. Do not hesitate to talk about it ... there may be people interested in becoming members around you!
